

Recursive Formulas- Type 1

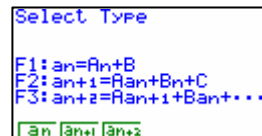

Select RECUR mode from the main menu by using the arrow keys to highlight the RECUR icon or pressing 8.

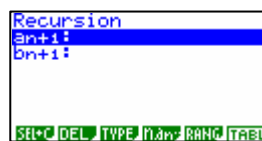


Can be used for arithmetic or geometric sequences.

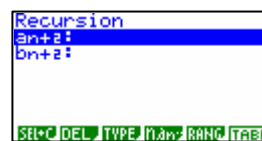
Note: There are 3 different settings for recursive formulas. There is one worksheet for each type.

Type 3

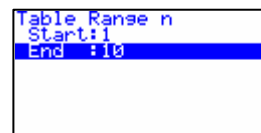
This worksheet deals with Type 1

Example: The sequence $\langle a_n \rangle = \langle 4n + 1 \rangle$,
List the first 10 terms of this sequence and draw the sequence.

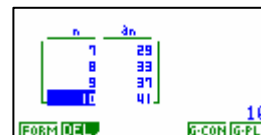
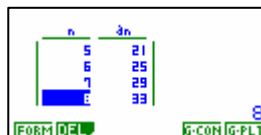
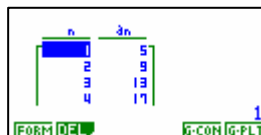
Answer: Enter in the equation of the sequence
Press **EXE** to store it.



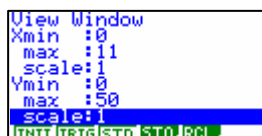
Then press **F5** to set up the calculator for the first 10 members of the sequence. Then **EXIT**



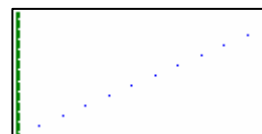
Then **F6** for the **TABLE**, to reveal the sequence shown below.



To draw the sequence make sure that you have set up the V-Window (x and y axes) to adequately draw the sequence. **SHIFT F3** to get the V-Window.



EXIT then **F6** to get the table again and **F6** for the plotted sequence values.
