

SETTING UP THE CALCULATOR

The calculator can be set up in different ways for doing and displaying the results of what is asked of it to do in the MODES from the MAIN MENU.

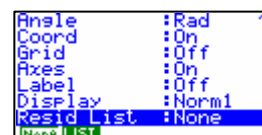
From the **MAIN MENU**

In **RUN** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **STAT** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **LIST** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **GRAPH** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **DYNA** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **TABLE** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **RECUR** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **CONICS** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



Once the changes have been made, then press EXIT

In **EQUA** mode Shift MENU then use the arrow and the F1 or the F2 or the F3 key, as appropriate



[Note: The Matrix mode has not been dealt with as matrices are not in the New Zealand Mathematics Curriculum]
